The Commission on the Status of Women (CSW) would like to remind you that the deadline for receipt of proposals for Mini Grants that promote the goals of CSW at the University of Arizona is Friday, February 15, 2008. Funds requested typically average \$400-\$600, and the proposed activity or project should occur from April, 2008 through June, 2009. Grant proposal requirements can be found at the CSW website, <http://csw.arizona.edu>. Proposals may be submitted by email CSW@email.arizona.edu, faxed to 626-7612, or delivered to the Diversity Resource Office, MLK Building Room 312. Submissions must be time stamped prior to midnight February 15.

Awards will be made based on the impact of the project to advance the following goals of the CSW at the University:

- * To identify and provide leadership on issues that affect women and other underrepresented groups.
- * To develop and support university policies and practices that promote equity and diversity
- * To promote advancement opportunities for women and other underrepresented groups
- * To collaborate with campus organizations and groups to create inclusive and safe communities
- * To foster individual and collective accountability that promotes justice, equity and diversity
- * To educate the campus community about the importance of developing a diverse and inclusive campus.

Priority Emphasis. The CSW priority emphasis for the 2008 Mini Grant Awards is family care. We especially invite projects that impact people and their families whether it is related to their children (i.e., child care) or their parents (i.e., elder care).

Eligibility

All members of the University of Arizona: students, faculty, and staff, departments and organizations are eligible to apply for the CSW grant funds.
