The Commission on the Status of Women (CSW) is seeking applications from individuals who are interested and enthusiastic about assisting in the efforts to create a just, equitable and inclusive campus environment. Women and men from all UA constituencies-faculty, appointed personnel and classified staff, graduate and undergraduate students-are encouraged to apply. The deadline for submission is 5 p.m., June 2, 2005. Detailed information about CSW and the application process is available at www.csw.arizona.edu.

Since 1992, CSW has worked to advise the president on issues that concern women and other underrepresented groups at the UA and within the Tri-University system. Moreover, CSW shapes policies and procedures and delivers services that meet the current needs of the UA community. Membership is by presidential appointment. Faculty, appointed personnel and classified staff are appointed for three-year terms. Students serve one-year renewable terms. A typical time commitment of 4 to 8 hours per month is required.

CSW projects and initiatives create professional development and leadership opportunities for its members.
